SMALL BUSINESS WEEK CONTEST RULES

THE SMALL BUSINESS WEEK CONTEST (THE "CONTEST") WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA ONLY AND SHALL BE CONSTRUED AND EVALUATED ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE CANADIAN LAW. NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY. ENTRANTS MUST BE OF THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONTEST RULES (THE "CONTEST RULES").

1. ELIGIBILITY.

- 1.1 To be eligible for this Contest, an individual must:
 - (a) be a legal resident of the province of Alberta;
 - (b) be of the age of majority in the province of Alberta or older at time of entry;
 - (c) be the sole owner of all right, title and interest (including copyright) in and to the Work (as defined below) submitted in connection with the Contest; and
 - -own their own business or an employee of the business that is located within one hundred kilometers (100km) of the city of Edmonton.
- 1.2 The following people are not eligible to enter the Contest:
 - (a) Employees of Corus Radio Inc., operating as CHED (the "Station") and its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (together with the Station, "Corus");
 - (b) Judges (as defined in Section 6 below) of the Contest;
 - (c) Any person who has been confirmed as a winner of two (2) Corus administered contests within six (6) months preceding the Contest start date indicated below; and
 - (d) The household members of any of the parties listed in Section (a) to (c) above.
- 1.3 Corus shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to Corus for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. Corus reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply information that does not meet these requirements.
- 2. CONTEST PERIOD. The Contest begins at 6:00 am Mountain Time ("MT") on October 9, 2024 and ends at 11:59 pm MT on October 20, 2024 (the "Contest Period") after which time the Contest will be closed and no further entries shall be accepted.

3. HOW TO ENTER.

- 3.1 There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. Enter using the method of entry outlined below. No entries will be accepted by any other means.
 - (a) To enter online, complete and submit the entry form located at https://globalnews.ca/edmonton/contest/10794493/880-ched-celebrates-small-business-week (the "Contest Microsite").
- 3.2 Each entrant must submit an entry form together with: (i) the name of the business; (ii) the story about/behind the business; (iii) the social media handle for the business; and (iv) the type of business (the "Work").
- 3.3 By participating in this Contest, each entrant represents and warrants that the Work: (i) does not contain any material, language or gestures that are libelous, defamatory, indecent, profane, obscene or violent and does not violate any laws including without limitation, relating to hate speech or otherwise; (ii) is original, solely created by the entrant and that no third party participated as an author, co-author or otherwise in the creation of the Work or any part thereof; (iii) all right, title and interest (including copyright) therein is owned and/or controlled by the entrant to the full extent necessary to enable Corus to use the Work as contemplated by these Contest Rules; (iv) the Work does not infringe upon the intellectual property rights, rights of publicity, privacy rights, proprietary interests or other statutory or common law rights of any third party; (v) does not contain any recognizable logos or any other copyrighted material; (vi) does not contain any mention, endorsement, or "plug" any commercial product, service, venture or thing, including, without limitation, the name of entrant's employer; and (vii) has not been submitted in connection with any other contest and/or promotional campaign.
- 3.4 Limit of one (1) entry per person during the Contest Period. In the case of multiple entries, only the first eligible entry will be considered.
- 3.5 All entries including the Work, become the sole property of Corus and will not be returned for any reason. Entries must be received no later than the end of the Contest Period. Entries will be declared invalid if they are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, irregular, mutilated, forged, garbled or mechanically or electronically reproduced. Unless otherwise set out herein, no communication or correspondence will be exchanged with entrants except with those selected as a potential winner.
- 3.6 Entries received online shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the entry. For the purpose of the Contest Rules, "authorized account holder" of an e-mail address is defined as the natural person who is assigned to an e-mail address by an Internet access provider, on-line service provider, or other organization responsible for assigning e-mail addresses for the domain associated with the submitted e-mail address. Any entrant may be required to provide Corus with proof that they are the authorized account holder of the e-mail address associated with their entry.

4. PRIZES.

- 4.1 There are three (3) prizes (collectively the "**Prizes**"), each, a "**Prize**") available to be won by the Prize winners (collectively the "**Winners**", each a "**Winners**") consisting of:
 - (a) One (1) custom advertising campaign curated by Corus.

- 4.2 Each Prize has an approximate value of five thousand Canadian dollars (CDN\$5,000).
- 4.3 Winners are not entitled to monetary difference between actual Prize value and stated approximate Prize value, if any.
- 4.4 Prizes will be distributed within two (2) days after each Winner has been successfully contacted and notified of their Prize and fulfilled the requirements set out herein.

5. PRIZE CONDITIONS.

- 5.1 Winners must be available to use the Prizes prior to December 31, 2025. Should a Winner be unable to utilize the Prize prior to the date designated by the Sponsors, the Prize will be forfeited and awarded to an alternate winner.
- 5.2 Prizes must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, assigned, substituted or redeemed for cash, except at the sole discretion of Corus. Any unused, unclaimed or declined portion of a Prize will be forfeited, have no cash value and Corus shall have no obligation to provide either an alternative or value-in-kind. Corus reserves the right, in their sole discretion, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if the Prize (or any portion thereof) cannot be awarded for any reason.
- 5.3 Shipped Prizes shall not be insured and Corus shall not assume any liability for lost, damaged or misdirected Prizes.

6. SELECTION.

- 6.1 Three (3) Winners shall be selected as follows:
 - (a) On or about October 21, 2024 in Edmonton, Alberta, three (3) entrants will selected by Corus and or Corus' representatives (the "Judges") based on the following equally weighted criteria: (i) why their business is deserving of the prize; (ii) the status of the business; and (iii) type of business (the "Criteria"). Each entrant shall be eligible to win only one (1) Prize. The odds of being selected as a potential winner are dependent upon the number of eligible entries received by Corus and the application of the Criteria to eligible entries by the Judges. Before being declared a Winner, each selected entrant shall be required to comply with the Contest Rules and to sign and return the Release (as described below).
 - (b) The Judges, in their absolute discretion, shall select the Winners based upon the above Criteria. The decisions of the Judges shall be final and binding and may not be challenged in any way.
 - (c) EACH SELECTED ENTRANT WILL BE NOTIFIED BY TELEPHONE AND/OR E-MAIL NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 21, 2024 AT 10:00A.M. MT AND MUST RESPOND WITHIN TWO (2) BUSINESS DAYS OF NOTIFICATION. Upon notification, the selected entrant must respond by telephone or e-mail (as specified in the notification) to the contact number or e-mail address provided no later than the indicated deadline set out in the Contest Rules and/or the notification. If the selected entrant does not respond accordingly, they will be disqualified and will not receive a Prize and another entrant may be selected in Corus' sole discretion until such time as an entrant satisfies the terms set out herein. Corus is not responsible for the failure for any reason whatsoever of a selected entrant to receive notification or for Corus to receive a selected entrant's

response.

- (d) If, as a result of an error relating to the entry process, drawing or any other aspect of the Contest, there are more selected entrants than contemplated in these Contest Rules, there will be a random draw amongst all eligible Prize claimants after the Contest's closing date to award the correct number of Prizes.
- 7. **RELEASE.** Potential Winners will be required to execute a legal agreement and release ("**Release**") that confirms each potential Winners': (i) eligibility for the Contest and compliance with these Contest Rules; (ii) acceptance of the Prize as offered; (iii) release of each of Corus and each of their employees, directors, officers, suppliers, agents, sponsors, administrators, licensees, representatives, advertising, media buying and promotional agencies (collectively, the "Releasees") from any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, cost or expense arising out of participation in the Contest, participation in any Contest-related activity or the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize, including but not limited to costs, injuries, losses related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation, or portrayal in a false light, or from any and all claims of third parties arising therefrom; and (iv) grant to Corus of the unrestricted right, in Corus' collective or individual discretion, to produce, reproduce, display, publish, convert, post, serve, broadcast, exhibit, distribute, adapt and otherwise use or re-use the Winner's name, statements, image, likeness, voice and biography; and the Work, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, in connection with the Contest and the promotion and exploitation thereof. The executed Release must be returned within two (2) business days of the date indicated on the accompanying letter of notification or the verification as a Winner or the selected entrant will be disqualified and the Prize forfeited.
- 8. INDEMNIFICATION BY ENTRANT. By entering the Contest, each entrant releases, indemnifies and holds Releasees harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, exposure to the COVID-19 virus, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from (a) their participation in the Contest or any Contest-related activity; (b) the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize; or (c) any breach of the Contest Rules. Each entrant agrees to fully indemnify the Releasees from any and all claims made by third parties relating to the entrant's participation in the Contest, without limitation.
- shall retain all right, title and interest (including copyright) in and to the Work and shall grant to Corus a worldwide, gratuitous, irrevocable, and exclusive license to copy, modify, produce, reproduce, display, publish, exhibit, distribute, convert, adapt, post, serve, broadcast, communicate by telecommunication, transmit and otherwise use or reuse the Work in all media now known or hereafter devised in perpetuity beginning on the date of entry, including, but not limited to, in connection with the administration, promotion and exploitation of the Contest. Corus is not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by website users or by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest. - 12.2 No communication unrelated to the Contest, commercial or otherwise, will be sent to the entrant unless the entrant otherwise expressly agrees to receive further communications from Corus.

All intellectual property, including but not limited to trade-marks, trade names, logos, designs, promotional materials, web pages, source code, drawings, illustrations, slogans and representations is owned by Corus and/or their affiliates. The Contest Rules are subject to change without notice in order to comply with any applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws or the policy of any other entity having jurisdiction over Corus.
